## BY TRAIN

## BY BUS

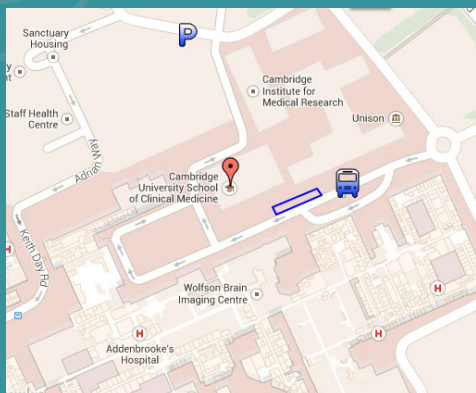
Buses from the railway station and the city centre run frequently to the Addenbrooke's Hospital site. For full timetable information please see the county council website.

## BY CAR

Addenbrooke's lies to the south-east of Cambridge City Centre, just off Hills Road (which becomes the A1307 to Haverhill), and near to Long Road and Queen Edith's Way.

## BY FOOT OR CYCLE

Walking from the city centre takes around an hour. From the railway station, the foot and cycle path alongside the guided busway makes for a pleasant half hour walk to the Clinical School.
