Call for Abstracts

Embolisation UK welcomes the submission of original abstracts for poster presentation at its annual meeting at the Birmingham Hilton Metropole between the 28th and 30th of March 2011.

General Guidelines

1. Abstracts must be received by **midnight Monday, the 21st of February**. The authors of accepted abstracts will be informed by email no later than Friday 25th February.
2. Submission of an abstract constitutes a commitment by the author(s) to present their work if the abstract is accepted.
3. Posters with either scientific or educational content (including case studies) will be considered.
4. All poster presenters must register for the meeting and pay any associated registration fees.
5. A first author may submit more than one abstract.
6. Abstracts are limited to 250 words and are to be constructed using the following section headings: Purpose; Materials and Methods; Results; Conclusion.
7. Changes to abstract titles or abstract text, as well as additions or deletions of author names, will not be permitted after submission.

Presentation Format

All posters should be in the standard A0 format.

Structure

The aim of the poster presentation is to convey to the viewer the essence of your topic in a relatively compact format. Abstracts for poster presentation will be selected by peer review.

Text must be well structured (use bullets for structuring), presenting only enough data to support your conclusion. Link the correct image to the text at the appropriate place.

Composition should be *logical, well organised, self-explanatory and as brief as possible*. The poster presentation must be non-promotional and non-commercial in nature. However, the specific agent and manufacturer must be clearly mentioned by name in cases where, for example, the central theme of the presentation is demonstrating specific differences between agents or materials.

Confidentiality

Patient confidentiality must be protected in all instances. There should be no names, hospital numbers or any other information that allows the patient to be identified in illustrations.

References

The accuracy of the references is the responsibility of the authors. The list of references should only include those that are cited in the text and that have been published.

Images

The origin and property of each image must be clearly stated or in case you use an image of already published material.
