Events Centre, Stewart House

BY TRAIN

Euston, King's Cross and St. Pancras mainline stations are within walking distance. The other London mainline stations are a short tube or taxi journey away.

BY BUS

Bus numbers 10, 24, 29, 73, 134, 390 all travel down Gower Street which is the main Senate House entrance. Stewart House can be accessed by passing through the main entrance on to the Russell Square side.

Buses 7, 188, 68, 168, 59 & X68 stop at Russell Square.

Buses 17, 45 and 46 stop in Gray's Inn Road. It is a short walk down Guildford Street to Russell Square.

BY TUBE

Russell Square (Piccadilly Line) remains the nearest tube station. Also within walking distance are:

Goodge Street (Northern Line)

Tottenham Court Road (Central Line and Northern Line)

Euston Square (Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan Lines)

Euston Station (Victoria & Northern Line)

King's Cross (Northern, Victoria, Hammersmith & City, Piccadilly, Circle and Metropolitan Lines)
