BY TRAIN

Southampton Central train station connects to London and all major cities and towns along the South Coast. For more information visit the National Rail website.

BY BUS

You can catch a bus from outside the main entrance on Tremona Road. Routes and times are available from the information point at the main entrance, where there is also a real time data board detailing actual bus arrival and departure times. The Bluestar 17 and City Red Three buses stop outside Southampton Central train station before continuing their journey to Southampton General Hospital and Princess Anne Hospital.
