BY TAXI

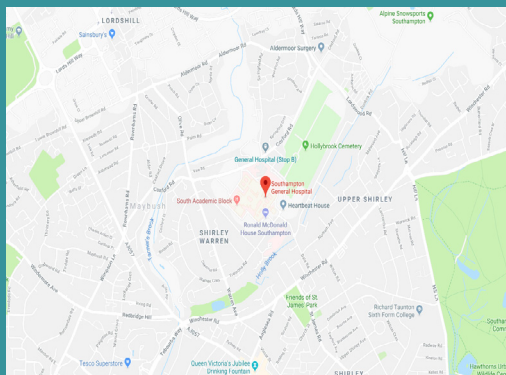
There is a taxi rank outside the main entrance, and a free taxi phone in the corridor just inside the main entrance.
