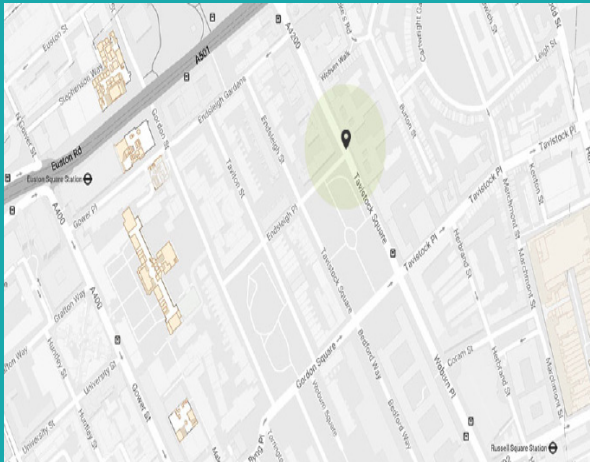
Attend mock interviews
