
## Al in radiology 2020, October 2020, Glasgow

#### N TRAIN

Edinburgh Waverley Station is 10 minutes' walk from the College. Please exit Waverley via the Market Street opening.

#### RY RUS

Inter-city bus services terminate at the St Andrew's Square Bus Station. Buses from Princes Street (stops on the side of the street lined by shops- [north]) are very frequent. Services passing the College include numbers 3, 5, 7, 8, 14, 30, 31 and 32
