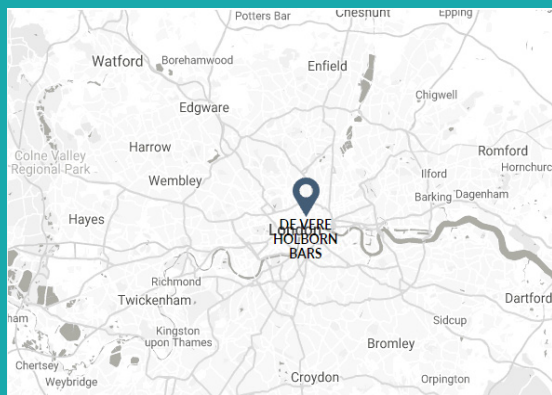

BY RAIL:

The nearest tube station is Chancery Lane on the Central Line. When leaving the station take exit number two and the entrance to Holborn Bars is located approximately 50 meters ahead in the large red brick building.

BY BUS:

From London Waterloo Station there are two bus services available, Bus 341 and 521. Alighting at Holborn Circus bus stop will ensure you are opposite the entrance to Holborn Bars. The 521 bus service runs Monday to Friday.

BY AIR:

The London City Airport is just over 8 miles from De Vere Holborn Bars. Take the DLR line to Bank and change to the Central Line, leaving at Chancery Lane. Exit the station via exit two and the entrance to Holborn Bars is in the large red brick building ahead.
