BY TRAIN

Leeds train station is only an 11 minute walk from Horizon Leeds

- Leave the station via the Marks and Spencer exit (directly in front of the exit barriers)
- Turn right onto New Station Street
- Walk to the end of New Station Str
- Cross Lower Briggate by Nando's and turn right
- Continue on to Bridge e
- Walk over the bridge
- Turn left onto Dock Street
- Turn right at the entrance to Brewery Wharf (this will be on your right)
- Walk to the end of the road
- Horizon Leeds will be on your left and Jury's Inn will
 be directly in front of you.
